Make an Audio Book for Independent Use

- 1. Choose a book you have permission to use, or be sure to not share/post publically.
- 2. Take and save an image of each page of the book. (I use a scanner or the PhotoScan App from Google on my phone.)
- 3. Save the images to your Google Drive in a folder with appropriate sharing settings **SET ALL PERMISSIONS** for Audio and Images in Google drive so anyone with the link can see the file!
- 4. Record the words/audio for each page as a separate file. (I use <u>Vocaroo.com</u> and download each audio and then upload these to Google Drive folder mentioned above.)
- 5. Open Google Slides. Put each page image on a separate slide in a presentation. (You may want to adjust the slide size to fit the book or the intended device(s).
- 6. On each slide choose "insert audio" and add the audio from your Google Drive to the page. Move the audio link to a corner of the page. Repeat for each page.
- 7. If you have a follow-up activity add that to the last slide.
- 8. RECHECK your permissions are all set so anyone with the link has access.
- 9. Publish this privately behind a log-in due to copyright permissions.
